

GOALIE CAMP INFORMATION SUMMER 2017

Registration:

You will register on Wednesday July 5th from 2:00pm – 3:30pm if you are a resident camper. Day campers will be from 3:00pm – 3:30pm. Registration will be in the lobby of the Ice Arena. On all registration days, we will start with a player parent meeting. After the meeting, each group will have a cookout, an ice session and a group activity. To see the daily schedule, go to the forms section of the Kent Hockey Schools web site at www.kenthockeyschools.com and find the daily schedule under the week and group you have signed up for.

Special Goalie Discounts:

Since you have signed up for the Goalie camp, you are eligible for attending an additional week of camp at a significantly reduced rate. The cost for the second week is \$350 for a resident camper and \$250 for a day camper. We allow up to four goalies in each group so it is on a first come basis. The way to get the discount is to sign up for another week of camp and pay the deposit of \$100. You will then email Bill Switaj at wswitaj@kenthockeyschools.com and let us know you have signed up. We will then adjust your balance to reflect the discount.

Housing (Resident Campers)

You will be housed in a dormitory located near the ice arena. You will be responsible for providing your own bed linens, blankets, pillow, towels etc... Because the dormitory is air-conditioned, it is important to bring a blanket. A sleeping bag is an alternative. We recommend that you do not bring a stereo, TV, appliance or other electronic components into the dormitory. Each room has a mini refrigerator and the floor has a microwave oven for the players to use. The Kent Hockey Schools is not responsible for lost or damaged appliances or any type of electronic components. You will also need a swim suit. A more detailed list of what to bring to camp can be found in the forms section of the Kent Hockey Schools web site.

Cell Phone Policy: We recommend that campers do not bring a cell phone. The dorm staff starting on Tuesday evening will let anyone who needs to make a call use their phone. However, if a camper does bring a cell phone it must be kept in their room at all times and they will only be allowed to use it in the evening hours.

Camp Bank (Both Day and Resident Campers)

Campers are encouraged to check spending money into the camp bank. From your bank account you can buy snacks, tape, drinks and get your skates sharpened. Also rock climbing and other activities at the Recreation and Wellness Center will be taken out of the camp bank. Campers will be informed by the middle of the week the week of their balance. Parents will receive the balance remaining in the account at the end of the week. There will be a \$3.50 service charge for the camp bank which will be deducted from your beginning balance.
